TO: COMMUNITY-BASED ORGANIZATIONS

To ensure continuity between the *First 5 LA Supportive Housing for Homeless Families Fund Rental Assistance and Supportive Services Program* (First 5 LA) and the *Family Solutions Center Program*, the income limit requirements for the First 5 LA Program have been revised.

Families with incomes up to 50% Area Median Income (AMI) are now eligible for Rapid Re-Housing Assistance under the First 5 LA Program. However, the number of families assisted with incomes between 30-50% AMI cannot exceed 25% of the total number of families served through Rapid Re-Housing Assistance.

The AMI limit must remain at 30% AMI for families served through Homelessness Prevention.
